### - MUSIC NOTES BY REBECCA TE VELDE -

**Prelude:** This chorale prelude by J.S. Bach (1685-1750) is a jaunty yet sturdy piece with nearly constant imitative melodic fragments that precede each entrance of the melody and continue beneath each melodic phrase. The featured solo reed stop is our refurbished Great Trumpet!

**Offertory and Postlude:** These are two variations from a new Partita on the tune of our closing hymn. The tune name, *Es flog ein kleins Waldvögelein*, is translated literally as "There flew a little forest birdie." Originally a German folksong that was first published in the 17<sup>th</sup> century, the tune migrated decisively to the church with a variety of texts that are sung across many denominations today, including three in *Glory to God* (393, 644, 733).

**Anthem:** This is the third movement of J. S. Bach's Cantata No. 79 titled "God the Lord is sun and shield". Bach's rhythmically-active orchestral accompaniment, here transcribed for organ, adds forward drive and bounce to the familiar hymn tune.




