

Due to several limitations and under the guidance of the Worship and Music Committee, our session voted to suspend the 8:30am service with the completion of our fall semester services in November. The remaining dates for this service will be October 22nd, November 12th and 19th.

#### MUSIC NOTES BY REBECCA TE VELDE

We thank Allison Ringler for playing French horn with and for us this morning! She is a graduate performance major studying with Prof. Lanette Lopez Compton at Oklahoma State University. We also are grateful for, and celebrate the gifts and musical offerings, of Brett Carver, who will take the organ bench for the Offertory, Doxology, closing hymn, and postlude.

**Prelude**: The hymn tune *Thaxted* is most commonly sung to the text "O God Beyond All Praising, We Worship You Today", although it has an alternate text in *Glory to God*, #341 "O God, Show Mercy to Us". Both texts are appropriate on this All Saints Sunday, and this piece, written for the wedding of son Brent and Jenny te Velde, is a steady crescendo from the softest organ to its *tutti* with the French horn.

**Offertory**: The very last compositions written by Johannes Brahms (1833-1897) were *Eleven Chorale Preludes* for organ. Written in 1896, they include this sublime setting of a communion hymn melody by Johann Crüger, which floats in long notes above Brahm's characteristic lush harmonies. You are invited to follow the text and melody of #514 in *Glory to God*.

**Communion**: This modern piece by Charles Callahan (b. 1951) is based on an ancient communion hymn from 1697 that is still in use globally across many denominations. You are invited to meditate on the text of hymn #495, which bears special meaning on this All Saints Sunday.

**Postlude**: Malcolm Archer (b. 1952) is an English composer, organist and conductor. He has served at Bristol, Wells, and St. Paul's Cathedrals and continues now as a freelance composer and conductor. This is his fast and furious toccata on the tune *All for Jesus* by John Stainer (1840-1901). The final stanza of this hymn of praise reads: "All for Jesus! All for Jesus! This the Church's song shall be, till at last the flock is gathered one in love, and one in thee." *Soli Deo Gloria*.

**Anthem**: Henry Gerike serves as kantor for Church of the Reformation—Lutheran in Affton, Missouri. He recently retired from serving as kantor at Concordia Seminary in St. Louis, where he also directed all campus choirs.


