## Music Notes by Rebecca te Velde

Today's voluntaries commemorate the Feb. 23 birth date of George Frideric Handel (1685-1759). Born and trained in Halle, Germany, he worked as a composer in Hamburg and Italy before settling in London, where he was given a state funeral and is buried in Westminster Abbey. A skilled organist and harpsichordist, his fame rests upon his oratorios, most especially *Messiah*, operas, chamber music and instrumental concertos.




